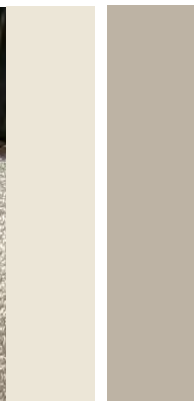
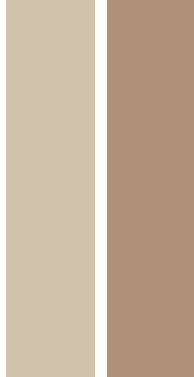
Soft Neutrals

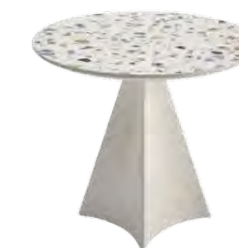

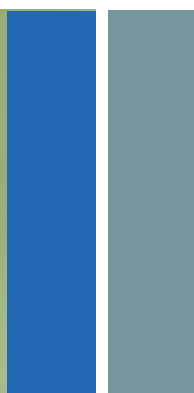
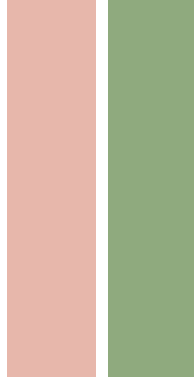
Edible Hues

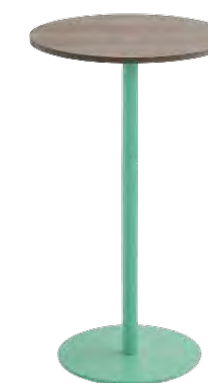

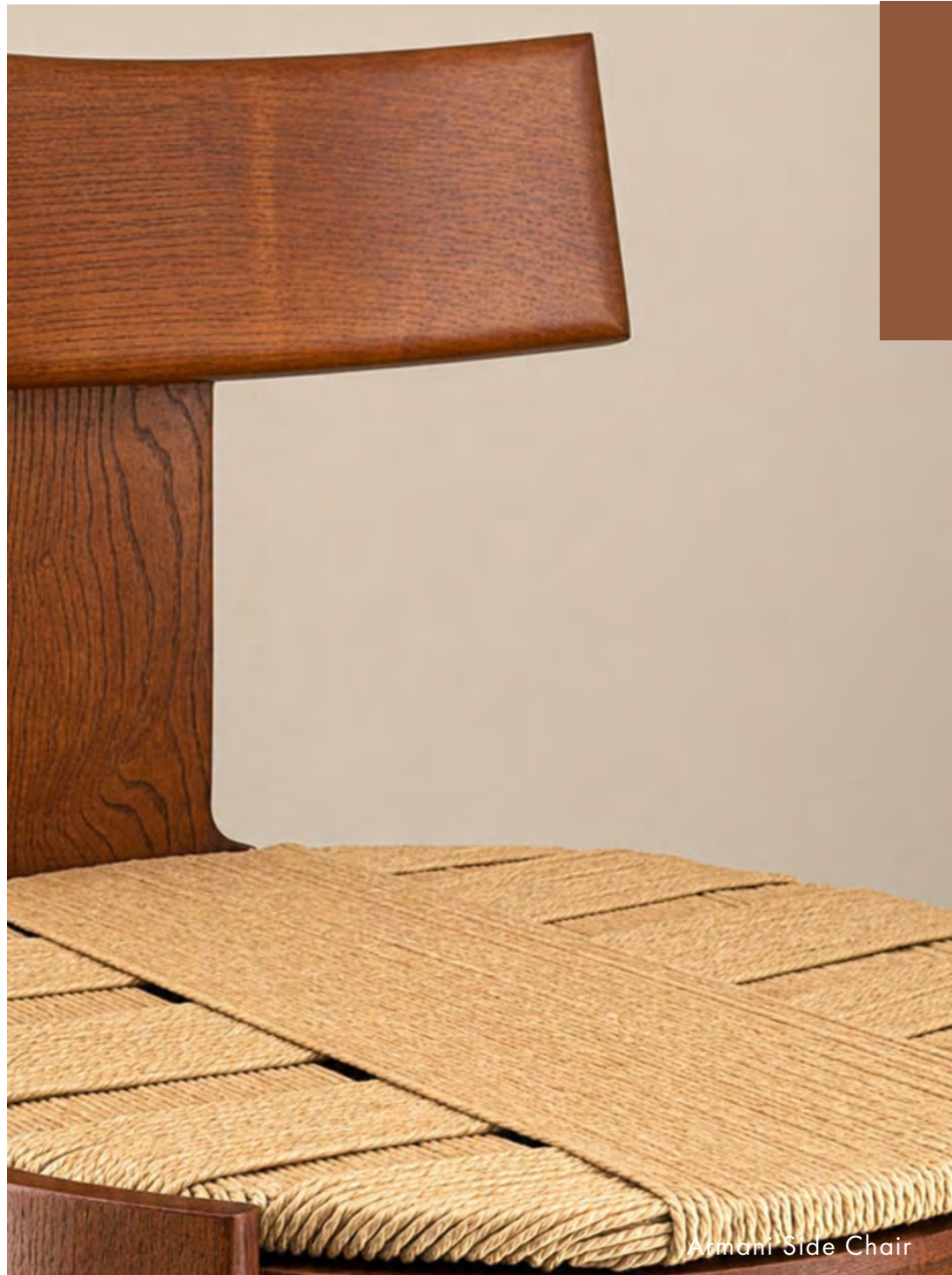
Layered Texture

Material

Texture is expressed through woven surfaces and defined layers. Natural fibres, chunky weaves and structured, layered detailing introduce tactile and visually engaging furniture, adding depth and rhythm. 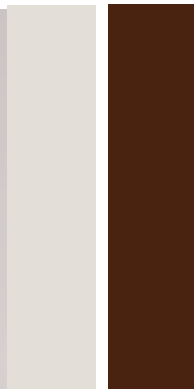
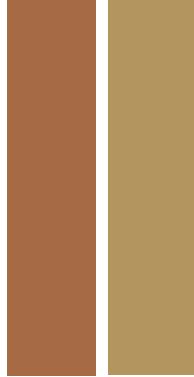
Soft Curves

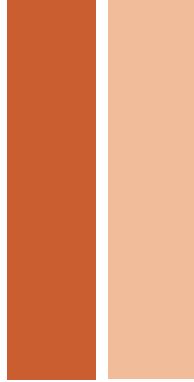

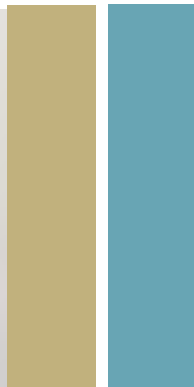
Retro Lines

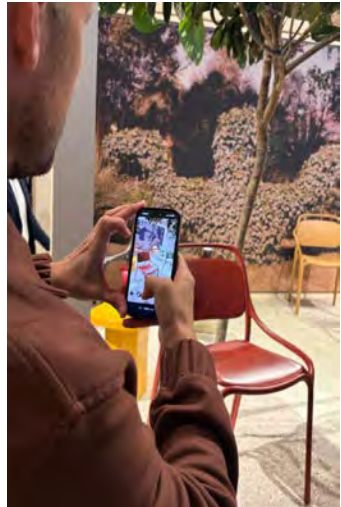
